Message from the East



Brothers,

I was recently talking with a brother who was saying that, "Every organization has a story... Our lodge has a story." By 'story' he didn't mean historical facts like who Ansantawae was or when our lodge was chartered. He meant the more current and dynamic story of who we are as a group.

Ansantawae is the largest lodge in the state by membership. At the end of 2016 we had 423 members on record. The Grand Lodge of Connecticut had 9,758 total members and we are 'the largest slice of the pie' at 4.3%.

We think of Ansantawae as being "Milford's Lodge", but actually only one third of us live IN Milford. Out of our 423 total members, 348 of us live in Connecticut. That's 82%. The next highest concentration of members is in Florida with 6.6% of us living there. The remainder of us, 11% or so, are scattered around the rest of the states. Ansantawae has members living in 23 of the 50 states.

According to Google Maps, the brother who lives closest to our temple at 59 Broad Street lives about 0.2 miles away on High Street. The brother living farthest away is in Menlo Park, California. He is 3,008 miles door-to-door. At the moment I'm not aware of any brothers living overseas, but we have at least one brother on active duty in the Navy so at any given time he might take the distance prize!

Speaking of our members, our oldest living brother was born in 1918 and will be 99 years old at the end of May. He joined the fraternity in 1963 when he was 45. Our longest serving brother joined when he was 26 and has been a Freemason for 68 years. On April 21st, at our Entered Apprentice degree, we initiated our newest member. That brother also holds the title of being our 'youngest member' having just recently turned 18.

As a group, our average age is 63 and we have been a Freemason for an average of 28 years. This suggests that most of us joined in our mid 30's. It has been said that the last large influx of members to Freemasonry was in the mid 1900's and our membership reflects that. 79% of us joined before 1967 (50yrs ago) and 21% have joined since then.

There's much more to Ansantawae's story, these statistics are just a beginning. We should regularly ask ourselves, and each other, questions like: Why did you become a Freemason? What do you enjoy most about going lodge? What has Freemasonry done for you? Etc. When you find a moment, I invite you to reach out to me and tell me YOUR part of our story. I'd love to hear from you. I hope to see you at lodge!


