Did You Know About The Following Piece Of Connecticut History?

We have learned from history that only one person signed all four major U.S. documents; Articles of Association, 1774, Declaration of Independence, 1776, Articles of Confederation, 1777 and United States Constitution, 1787.

Roger Sherman was a Mason. His Masonic apron is in display in the Yale University Museum in New Haven.

He was born in Newton, Massachusetts in 1721, but following graduating from Yale Law School, he became a Connecticut resident. He was admitted to the bar in 1754, served in the Connecticut Assembly, 1755-1766 and the State Senate, 1766-1785. In addition, he served as U.S. Senator from 1791 until his death in 1793.

He was chosen as a delegate to the Continental Congress, was on the committee to draft the Declaration of Independence with Brothers Benjamin Franklin, Thomas Jefferson, John Adams and Robert Livingston. He also helped draft the Articles of the Confederation, made 133 speeches during the Constitutional Convention, helped draft the Connecticut Compromise and authored a major section of the Constitution.

Bro. Patrick Henry described him as one of the three greatest men at the Constitution Convention.

All Connecticut Masons should be proud of his accomplishments.
