### Ansantawae Lodge Secretary's Corner



My Brothers;

A bit of history from WWII. The following letter was sent to all Connecticut Masonic Lodges, which I thought might interest all Lodge members, especially those of us who lived through or served during that war.

### Dear Brethren;

"The United States Treasury Department has called upon me as Grand Master of Masons in Connecticut, to continue to champion the ideals of Masonry; life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness, by sponsoring a nationwide War Savings Bond Program in every Lodge within my jurisdiction, for the period, November 15 through December 31, 1942.

Today, three ruffians; Hitler, Hirohito and Mussolini, are seeking to destroy that which we as Masons, are taught to consider as one of our Landmarks; Love of Country.

Let us therefore, heed the call of our country and purchase these War Bonds during this period, reporting each purchase to your Secretary so that I, as Grand Master, may report what Connecticut Masons have done while this nationwide War Savings Bond Program is running.

It is my desire that this matter be mentioned at every Stated Communication between the above dates and that the Trustees of each Lodge consider the advisability of investing funds in their care."

The letter was read at the November 5th Stated Communication and although Bond purchases by members may never be known, the Annual Report of the Treasurer indicated that the Lodge purchased a \$2,500 F War Bond for the price of \$1,850.
