Lodge opens at 7:45pm and light refreshments will follow the meeting.

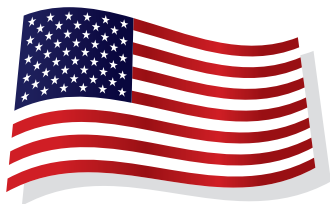

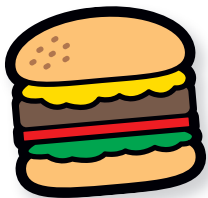

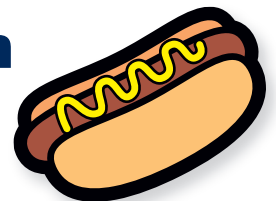
