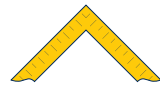

JOURNEY TO THE Moon

As Freemasons, we learn that Geometry is the first and noblest of sciences and by it, we discover how the planets move in their different orbits, and demonstrate their various revolutions. All framed by the Grand Artificer of the Universe.

On May 25, 1961, President John F. Kennedy announced before a special joint session of Congress the dramatic and ambitious goal of sending an American safely to the Moon before the end of the decade. Men and women of NASA were inspired by the liberal arts and sciences, *grammar, rhetoric, logic, arithmetic, geometry* and *astronomy*. Resulting in **Project Apollo** becoming a reality by 1969 and the human race would set out to journey to the Moon.

Apollo 11 launched from Cape Kennedy on July 16th 1969, carrying Commander **Neil Armstrong**, Command Module Pilot **Michael Collins** and Lunar Module Pilot **Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin**. Commander Neil Armstrong and lunar module pilot Buzz Aldrin, landed the Apollo Lunar Module Eagle on **July 20, 1969, at 20:17 UTC**.

Fifty years ago, the world watched two brave men journey and take those historic first steps. Armstrong became the first person to step onto the lunar surface six hours later on **July 21 at 02:56:15 UTC**. Aldrin joined him 19 minutes later.

Edwin Eugene "Buzz" Aldrin was born on January 20, 1930 and became the second man to walk on the moon. The first Freemason to set foot upon that celestial globe.



Long before his first step on the surface of the moon. He took his first steps in a Masonic Lodge and was **Initiated** at Oak Park Lodge No. 864, Montgomery, Alabama, on February 17, 1955; **Passed to Fellowcraft** on April 12, 1955; **Raised** to the Sublime degree of Master Mason in Lawrence N. Greenleaf Lodge, No. 169 in Denver, Colorado. On February 21, 1956, York Rite Degrees, Waco Texas and on May, 1967 Member Arabia Shrine Temple, Houston.

As we approach the golden anniversary of one of mankind's greatest achievements, traveling to the celestial globe that governs the night. We as a fraternity can take pride in the fact that Bro. Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin made his mark on history and stepped off as a Brother on the surface of the Moon.

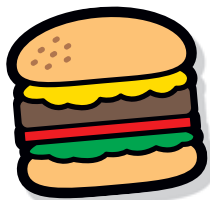

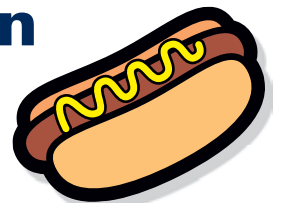

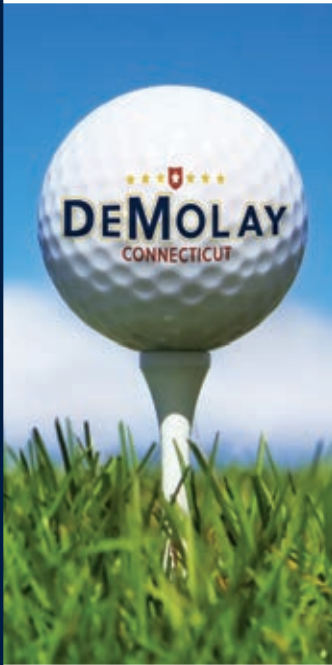
