




February marks the observance of **Presidents Day**, celebrating United States Presidents, past and present. "First in War, First in Peace, and First in the hearts of his countrymen", our Masonic Brother George Washington holds a position of high esteem and honor.

In tribute, The Washington Monument, designed by Robert Mills and eventually completed by Thomas Casey and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, memorializes George Washington at the center of the nation's capital. The structure was completed in two phases of construction, one private (1848-1854) and one public (1876-1884). Built-in the shape of an Egyptian obelisk, evoking the timelessness of ancient civilizations, the Washington Monument embodies the awe, respect, and gratitude the nation felt for its most essential Founding Father.

At the 1848 cornerstone laying ceremony, freemasons performed the rite using Brother Washington's masonic tools of which 20,000 people were in attendance. A container held copies of the Constitution, the Declaration of Independence, and other objects that were buried in the cornerstone.

The Monument's marble blocks are held together by just gravity and friction, and no mortar was used in the process. The top of the monument has an aluminum cap inscribed with, notable names and dates in the monument's construction, and on the East face, facing the rising sun, the Latin words "Laus Deo," which translate to, "Praise be to God."
