### MESSAGE FROM THE EAST



Greetings Brothers,

I hope you have all had a relaxing and enjoyable holiday season and new year!

Thank you for entrusting me to lead Ansantawae Lodge No. 89 for the 2023 year. It is an honor to join the ranks of the 138 Past Masters that have come before me, and I hope that I can live up to the examples that these great men have set.

While planning my year in the East I came across a booklet of the history of Ansantawae Lodge that was prepared for our 125th anniversary. This booklet has summaries of every year from 1859 through 1984 and quite a bit can be learned by flipping through it. For example, I learned that 50 years ago, the year that MWB Kenneth B. Hawkins was installed as Worshipful Master, we ended the year with 635 members and the annual Strawberry Festival had an attendance of 160 people.

It should be no shock to hear that our membership and attendance have decreased significantly in the past 50 years. The decline in membership was discussed by MWB Bruce R. Bellmore in his April 2022 Grand Master's Message and he referenced a study done by Scottish Rite across the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction that found the overwhelming majority of brothers who demitted or went NPD did so because of lack of engagement. Despite what you may think, this is great news! There will always be factors beyond our control, but a lack of engagement is something we have control over.

My brothers, my goal this year is to increase Ansantawae Lodge's engagement. I aim to improve the engagement of our members, not just within our lodge, but with the other lodges in our district and state, as well as with our Milford and Orange communities. However, I can only do so much as Worshipful Master. If this year is to be a success, I will need the assistance of you, my brothers. I encourage you all to reach out to brothers you may not have seen a while, talk with the new brothers and help them feel welcomed so they can see what our lodge is all about, travel to other lodges, and attend Blue Lodge Council meetings.

Lastly, as part of this goal to increase engagement, I will be establishing three committees this year. The committees will be focused on fellowship, fundraising, and public relations and I am looking for brothers that are interested in running and/or participating in these committees. Please let me know if you have an interest in taking part in these committees.

# Masonic words and phrases.

**Worshipful** – As used in Worshipful Master, from the Anglo-Saxon, **Worthship** (worthy); honorable or respectable. Used as a respectful form of address. The term has no religious or sacred implication.



**Warden** – "Ward" is of Medieval origin, having been used in early English, French, German, etc., always in the sense of to guard something, a meaning preserved in warden, guard, guardian, wary, ware, ward, etc. A warden is guardian of the west gate of the Temple, the Junior Warden of the south gate.
