MESSAGE FROM THE EAST



Greetings Brothers,

September is here, our two-month break is over, it's time to get back to labor and boy do we have a lot of work to do!

First, I want to thank everybody who participated in the Fellowcraft Picnic in July. We sold over 50 tickets and most people that bought tickets attended. There was food, drinks, and fellowship to be had by all and the event was a greater success than I could have hoped for. While the Fellowcraft Picnic has never been a big fundraiser for the lodge (at least not since I have been a member), I am happy to say we made a profit for the first time in several years. This event would not have been the success it was if it were not for the team of officers that worked hard to put this together, thank you all for your efforts.

I mentioned there is a lot of work to do and that work has to do with Project Blue Wave. If you are not aware, Project Blue Wave is the Grand Lodge's effort to raise awareness of Freemasonry in Connecticut and grow our numbers with quality Brothers. Previously, Project Blue Wave was only being tested at a handful of lodges, however, our time to participate has now come and we are already seeing an influx of candidates. As I write this, we have 16 inquiries, 10 of which have come over the break. The influx of inquiries is expected to increase as the program gets fully up and running and Project Blue Wave has created a new role called Prospect Manager. Traditionally, the Senior Warden has been responsible for reaching out to prospects and gauging if they would be good candidates of Freemasonry. However, with the influx of inquiries, we feel it might be a better idea to have a separate prospect manager whose sole responsibility will be to reach out to prospects and find out if they would be a good fit for our lodge. If this is a position that interests you, please reach out to me for more details.

Lastly, if these 16 inquiries turn into candidates, it may be necessary for us to hold special meetings for the purpose of degree work. We are not at that point yet, but I want to make you all aware that it is a possibility as having degrees as special meetings may require greater assistance from the craft depending on the schedules of the officers. If we do have a need-a-run specials, we will give you ample notice so that you may assist or attend.

These are exciting times and I feel the future of Freemasonry, and Ansantawae Lodge, is bright! I look forward to seeing you all back at lodge.
