PETITION AND DISPENSATION – 1859

At a meeting of Master Masons residing in the Tovvn of Milford, October 13th, A.L. 5859, it was agreed to PETITION to the GRAND LODGE of the STATE of Connecticut for a DISPENSATION empowering them to confer the three degrees of Masonry, the Lodge to be called the ANSANTAWAE, Lodge.

A PETITION was therefore drawn up and signed by the following Master Masons:
