Masonic words and phrases

Balloting – Balloting on the acceptance or rejection of a candidate is secret. Small round white balls and black cubes are used in the voting. White balls elect; black cubes reject. In casting the ballot, all lodge members are required to base their ballot on personal knowledge, information of the committee on investigation, and reputed character the candidate. Under no circumstances are members to allow themselves to be influenced by personal likes and dislikes of the candidate or by a spirit of prejudice or revenge. Every member of the lodge is required to vote conscientiously for the good of the Order and in Brotherly consideration of the applicant.


